WELCOME TO ST MARY'S

PARKING IN THE CHURCHYARD: restoration of the spire commences on Monday 13th January and from that date the churchyard effectively becomes a building site. Therefore, **there will be no car parking, turning or dropping off in the churchyard on any weekday until further notice.** In fact, the churchyard gates will be kept closed. The only exception is for those needing to come by car to the Thursday morning Communion service.
