Last year our Foodbank fed 21% more people than the year before and in May fed 243 people including 87 children. Our foodbank urgently needs sugar, long life milk, juice, jam, rice pudding and tinned fruit in addition to medium sized soap powder & fabric conditioner, toothpaste, shower gel & shampoo. Nappies are also urgently needed. **Donations from St Mary’s are hugely important. Please do help to make a difference if you possibly can.**
