ELECTORAL ROLL. The annual revision of the church electoral roll is about to take place. If your name is not already on the roll and you wish to be included (eg: because you have joined the congregation during the past year or recently reached the age of 16), please complete an application form (at the cross aisles) and **return it to the Parish Office or to one of the Clergy by Monday 27th March**. If you are already on the roll, but your name/address /email has changed, please let us know (making it clear that you are already on the roll) so that we may update the roll.

BACH ST MATTHEW'S PASSION. On Palm Sunday we are going to be staging a liturgical performance of Bach's St Matthew Passion. The congregation will be invited to join in with four of the chorales during the Passion. In preparation for this, we are going to use a verse from one of the less familiar chorales to herald the Gospel during Lent this year, in place of the gradual hymn, so that we can learn it before the service on Palm Sunday. The choir will sing the chorale once and then everyone will sing it a second time.

Please note there will be **NO Traidcraft stall TODAY, March 5th**.

As part of **Yunghee's training course on Christian ethics**, she has been asked to give a **presentation regarding 'Whether we, as Christians, should support migration into our country'**. Please come and support her at **8pm on Wednesday 15th March in Garden Hall**.

PSALMS AT EVENSONG: following the recent consultation about congregational singing of the psalms, the result was that a small majority of people would prefer to sing the psalms, however a significant number would prefer to listen to the choir. The Rector and Director of Music have therefore agreed that we will alternate between choir only (congregation seated) and the choir & congregation singing the psalms at Evensong. Congregational psalm singing will be taught by Max on the relevant Sundays before the service.
