Annual Parochial Church Council Meeting

Insurance Officer for the Wimbledon PCC

We are looking for a new Insurance Officer for the Wimbledon PCC. The IO has oversight of insurance matters relating to the four Churches and associated properties, and acts as liaison between "us" and our insurance company and broker. Responsibilities include (a) handling/coordinating insurance claims made against us and that we are making, (b) advising wardens and the PCC generally on insurance-related matters and coverage and (c) handling annual policy renewals and obtaining approvals from the PCC. In addition, the IO serves as a Trustee of the Wimbledon PCC and in that capacity attends quarterly meetings of the PCC

The role ideally requires some insurance-related background but formal sector experience is not a pre-requisite. The PCC retains the services of a broker who has the specialist knowledge of and advises the IO on the 'nuts and bolts' of policy matters. Wimbledon Tennis Parking

After another highly successful 2018 Tennis Parking season, preparations are already underway to ensure the continued success of the use of the Church field this year. Last year, we raised £41,856, of which £4,500 went directly to charity and the balance to general church funds enabling us to continue our major support for the Diocese. We are now reaching out to experienced and potential future volunteers to assist in this most rewarding activity. This year we have decided to open the Field on Sunday 19th May for the inauguration of the new Number 1 court, when there will be no other official car parking available.
