Replastering in Church

We will be commencing replastering the areas of decayed and blistered wall render to the west of the church and in the South Porch. This work is anticipated to take 13 weeks and planned to commence in October. There will be considerable dust at some points from this project and there will be enhanced professional cleaning of the church during this time. Any disruption will be minimised as much as possible however, screens and building equipment may be present during services.

Merton Winter Night Shelter
